Myron Darel "Pooch" Caldwell, 89 of New Castle, departed from this world and entered into heaven's gates on Sunday, August 23, 2015. Myron had been very ill for a long time and was being cared for by his loving wife and family.

Myron was a veteran of World War II, having served as a signalman on the USS Tabberer in the Pacific Campaign.
