



## Clyde Straley Givens Jr

Clyde Straley Givens, Jr., 86 of Daleville, VA passed away February 27, 2021. He was preceded in death by his parents, Clyde Straley Givens, Sr. and Vinnie Pearl Montgomery; brother, Clarence Brown Givens.
